Keynote: Lev Grossman

Lev Grossman is a senior writer at *Time Magazine* as both the book critic and lead technology writer. He's also a bestselling author himself. Drawing on his own expertise and extensive conversations with major cultural figures, Grossman brings a uniquely qualified, humanistic eye to the complex and unprecedented ways in which technology and culture are merging.

Lev Grossman has spoken in-depth with Mark Zuckerberg, Steve Jobs, Bill Gates, Stephenie Meyer, J.K. Rowling, Jonathan Franzen, and many others. His book, *The Magicians* earned a rare combination of popular and critical acclaim -- it debuted at #8 on the *New York Times* bestseller list and was one of

the *New Yorker's* best books of 2009. The sequel, *The Magician King*, picks up where *The Magicians* left off and has also become a *New York Times* bestseller. NPR called it "triumphant" -- "a spellbinding stereograph, a literary adventure novel that is also about a privilege, power and the limits of being human."

Grossman's award-winning journalism has also appeared in the *Times*, *the Village Voice*, *Entertainment Weekly*, *Salon*, *Wired*, *The Believer* and the *Wall Street Journal*, among many others, and he is a frequent guest on NPR. Grossman has degrees in comparative literature from Harvard and Yale. He lives in Brooklyn, NY.

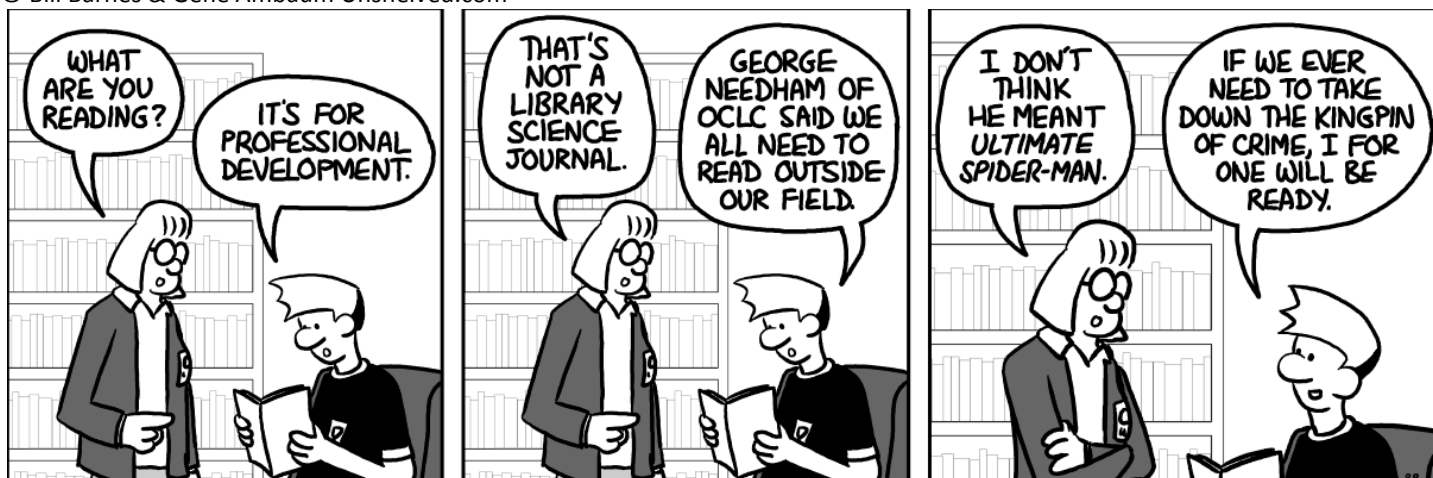

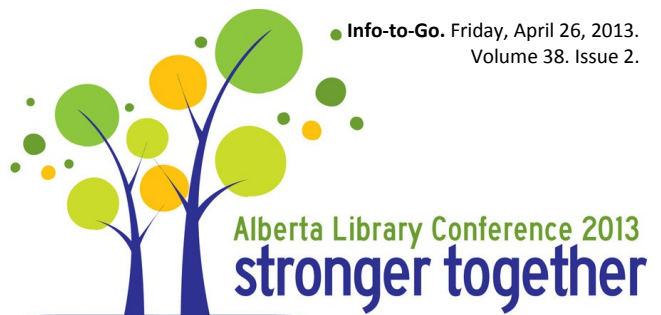
